You will need to place your wrist band on the sign on tally boards when launching and retrieve the wrist band when safely back on shore.

AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM OUR HOST CLUB

Dear Sailors,

We hope you have been enjoying the facilities here at Sandringham Yacht Club. Leading up to the 2020 ILCA Laser Radial Women's and Men's World Championships, we would like to confirm a few items and request some information from you. To ensure a smooth transition of equipment leading up to and following the completion of the Regatta please note.

1. Sailors will be training using either a Laser charter or your own Lasers.
 - a. Before you receive your world title charter vessel (including for pre-event charter), you will need to have removed your training vessel from the club.
 - b. If you are returning a Laser back to a charter company, they must remove the boat from SYC.
2. During the 6 race days of the Laser Standard Men's Laser World Championships 9th to the 16th February.
 - a. All Radial sailors are to keep their boats in Zone 1 during this event
 - b. We request that the women and men Radial sailors that are training launch and return for training 1 hour prior to the Standard Men's race so that dolly's are not hindering the launch of the Men's Standard fleet, and/or
 - c. Launch after the last Standard has been launched ensuring their dolly is removed from the launch area.
 - d. Training sailors should return well before the final Standard race is completed or after all Standard sailors have returned and are signed off.
3. Coach boats - please depart and return your rib from your allocated berth. **Coach Boats must not park ribs on docks near the boat ramp or travel lift on the fingers near cranes**, unless being lifted or coming out of the water.
4. Departure following the end of the Laser Radial Women's and Men's World Championships on 28th February it is anticipated;
 - a. all charter boats will be returned to PSA.
 - b. teams will want to pack containers with Ribs and Lasers for on forwarding to your next training competition venue.
 - c. Some teams have already contacted us and requested time slots for live load of containers which is usually a 2-hour slot. Please when requesting a slot make sure that your equipment is ready to be loaded and your personnel are ready for the loading of the container.
 - d. Unfortunately, SYC is not in a position to accommodate overnight or extended container stays
